**Troop meetings** are held 7:00 - 8:30 pm every Thursday year-round in the Troop Lodge (the Brentwood United Methodist Church youth area under the educational wing, except as noted here or otherwise announced.

Please Arrive by 6:45-6:55 pm. Help set up the Lodge. Be in the Lodge on time for opening ceremony in the appropriate uniform of the day. Help clean up after Closing. Depart 8:35-8:45 pm. Troop Games, when included in the program, are normally conducted on the grounds, in the gym, or in the Troop Lodge, as befits the weather and program,

**Dangerous Weather Policy:** Regular Thursday night meetings are cancelled if **Nashville Public Schools** close due to weather.

**Troop Committee** meets in the Scout Master's Lodge the first Monday of each month beginning at 7:00 pm except as noted here or otherwise announced, and we hope are over by 9:00 pm.

**Patrol Leader Council (PLC)** – Made up of SPL and APSL, members of the Sr. Patrol, and Patrol Leaders or their designates, meets at 6:30 prior to the regular meeting

**Respects for BUMC Facilities** – Scouts are to stay in the Youth Area or assigned meeting location and are not to wonder throughout the building. Leaving the meeting area requires the approval of a Troop One adult leader.

**Uniform Standards:** The Quarter Master has official Troop 1 T-shirts, caps, and other accessories, and occasionally has handed down Class A uniform elements available to borrow for Boards and Courts.

Class A formal includes these BSA uniform elements: tan BSA uniform shirt (proper patches affixed), neckerchief & slide, merit badge sash, belt & buckle, pants or shorts & socks. A Cap is optional. A suit can substitute. Class A Formal uniform is required for a Board of Review for all ranks, for Court of Honor, when representing Troop One at outside meetings and at the Spaghetti Supper. Class A informal includes tan BSA uniform shirt (proper patches affixed) for Troop meetings from Labor Day until Scout Camp week, for all travel. (Formal is always encouraged.)

Class B includes a Troop or other official Scout T-shirt and is appropriate for Troop Meetings after June 1 until Labor Day

**Travel & Camping** always requires permission forms and Class A informal unless otherwise specifically announced. Yearly Permission Slips can be submitted in lieu of individual permission slips Scouts using Troop gear are responsible for returning gear clean, in good repair, and ready for its next use.

Scouts may be required to use Troop tents on some trips. Group transportation is recruited by the Trip Leader from participating adult leaders and parents as available. An adequate but minimum number of vehicles are encouraged.

Scouts are not allowed to drive themselves except with special cause and permission. Upon return, Scouts are to stay and assist in cleaning group transportation, Troop trailer and stowing Troop gear.
